Report of Treasurer

Vickie Herring presented the Treasurer's report. Our total balance as of 12/31/08 is \$20,603.43 with monies held in reserve for the Health & Education Fund of \$3,944.14 and the Trophy Fund of (\$257.21), resulting in a General Fund balance of \$16,402.08. There are no monies owed to the Club outstanding, no monies /expenses owed by the Club outstanding and no monies received not yet deposited.

The Holiday Party net loss was \$525.70, resulting in the Club paying \$18.13 per person for the event.

A suggestion was made during discussions that donations to the Trophy Fund be included on email reminders about the Specialty to the cavalier list communications.

Vickie Herring also presented the 2008 year end Treasurers Report, detailing income and expenses for the calendar year, including a detailed 2008 vs. 2007 comparison of income and expenses, and a 5 year profit/loss analysis.

Renewal & Breeder Referrals Update: The members who have not paid dues are considered past due. Thirty three (33) of fifty three (53) members have renewed. Twenty one (21) of our fifty three (53) Associate members have renewed including Juniors and 2 Honorary members. Twenty (20) Breeder Referrals have been updated. Our total membership, if all existing members renew, will be 115 members.






