<u>Doggie Christmas</u> Cookies

Ingredients:

1/2 cup cornmeal
2 cups whole wheat flour
6 Tbsp vegetable oil
2/3 cup water or broth
(chicken or beef)

Directions:

Mix the cornmeal and flour together.

Add the oil and water(or broth) to the dry ingredients—the fun part is that it is best mixed together using your hands!

To make it festive, you can add red or green food coloring to the mixture.

Once the dough is a consistency where it can be rolled out, take a rolling pin and roll out the dough onto a floured surface to about 1/4" thickness. Cut out festive shapes using a cookie cutter or just free form!

Place the cut outs on a parchment lined cookie sheet and bake at 350 degrees for 30-35 minutes. Let cool and store in plastic bags or containers.




